EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of this bill would result in a potential minimal revenue loss to the State. The bill repeals PA 92-175 "An Act Imposing Penalties for Failure to Comply With the Requirements of Transportation Management Programs Required Pursuant to the Clean Air Act". Since the act contained various penalties for noncompliance with certain provisions of the Clean Air Act and associated programs, these penalties would no longer apply.

The bill also makes various technical changes which do not result in a fiscal impact.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: Passage of the bill would result in a potential minimal savings to municipalities. Since PA 92-175 imposed certain penalties which would apply to municipalities, the repeal of the act would eliminate the potential for cost related to noncompliance with the provisions of the act.
