TITLE: "RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO AMEND THE CONSOLIDATED OMNIBUS BUDGET RECONCILIATION ACT OF 1985"

FAVORABLY REPORTED BY Public Health

SUMMARY: The resolution calls upon the congress of the United States to amend the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 to extend the time period for which group health insurance coverage is available. It also calls for congress to restore the deduction for State sales taxes paid by the individual for the calculation of federal taxable income for the federal income tax.
