STATE IMPACT: Costs shown are for the 2,597 All Funds employees, including the 642 General Fund and 315 Transportation Fund employees covered by this contract. The annualized FY 2000-2001 cost associated with this contract is \$24,544,351 for All Funds, of which \$6,419,162 is for the General Fund and \$2,942,214 is for the Transportation Fund.
