House of Representatives, April 1, 1998. The Committee on Labor and Public Employees reported through REP. DONOVAN, 84th DIST., Chairman of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING PREMIUM PAY FOR SUNDAY AND HOLIDAY WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) No person shall be employed on a Sunday
2 or on a state or federal holiday in any retail
3 establishment occupying a total retail sales area
4 of more than forty thousand square feet unless
5 such person receives remuneration for his
6 employment on any such day at a rate not less than
7 one and one-half times his regular rate of pay.
