RESOLUTION CONCERNING A SISTER-STATE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT AND THE ITALIAN PROVINCE OF SICILY.

1 Resolved by this Assembly:

2 WHEREAS, the Italian Province of Sicily is an
3 important trading and cultural partner of the
4 State of Connecticut; and

5 WHEREAS, the people of the Province of Sicily
6 have shared a traditional friendship and cordial
7 relationship with the people of Connecticut,
8 through the exchange of ideas and people; and

9 WHEREAS, a sister-state relationship between
10 the Province of Sicily and the State of
11 Connecticut will establish greater friendship and
12 understanding between the people of Connecticut
13 and the people of Sicily through the exchange of
14 ideas, education and people; and

15 WHEREAS, such a sister-state relationship
16 would mark another milestone in the economic,
17 educational, social and cultural development of
18 both the State of Connecticut and the Province of
19 Sicily.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the
21 Connecticut General Assembly expresses its
22 commitment to the establishment of a sister-state
23 relationship with the Province of Sicily; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this
25 resolution be sent to the appropriate officials of
26 the Province of Sicily and to each member of the
27 Connecticut congressional delegation.
