AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPENDITURES OF THE OFFICE OF POLICY AND MANAGEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
2 and Management shall review the functions and
3 activities of the Office of Policy and Management
4 in order to evaluate the cost-effectiveness and
5 benefits of such functions and activities and
6 assign priority for their continued funding. The
7 secretary shall submit findings and
8 recommendations to the joint standing committee of
9 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
10 relating to appropriations and the budgets of
11 state agencies not later than January 13, 1999,
12 and annually thereafter.
