AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The board of trustees of The University  
2 of Connecticut shall review the programs and  
3 services administered or provided by the  
4 university in order to assess the effectiveness  
5 and benefits of such programs and services and  
6 assign priority for their continued funding. The  
7 board shall report its findings and  
8 recommendations to the joint standing committee of  
9 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
10 relating to appropriations and the budgets of  
11 state agencies not later than January 13, 1999,  
12 and annually thereafter.
