AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENTS OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND PUBLIC WORKS AND THE STATE PROPERTIES REVIEW BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) The Commissioner of
2 Administrative Services shall review the functions
3 and activities of the department in order to
4 assess the cost-effectiveness of such functions
5 and activities and assign priority for their
6 continued funding. The commissioner shall submit
7 findings and recommendations to the joint standing
8 committee of the General Assembly having
9 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations
10 and the budgets of state agencies not later than
11 January 13, 1999, and annually thereafter.

12 Sec. 2. (NEW) The Commissioner of Public
13 Works shall review the functions and activities of
14 the department in order to assess the
15 cost-effectiveness of such functions and
16 activities and assign priority for their continued
17 funding. The commissioner shall submit findings
18 and recommendations to the joint standing
19 committee of the General Assembly having
20 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations
21 and the budgets of state agencies not later than
22 January 13, 1999, and annually thereafter.

23 Sec. 3. (NEW) The chairperson of the State
24 Properties Review Board shall review the functions
25 and activities of the board in order to assess the
26 cost-effectiveness of such functions and
27 activities and assign priority for their continued
28 funding. The chairperson shall submit findings and
29 recommendations to the joint standing committee of
30 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
31 relating to appropriations and the budgets of
32 state agencies not later than January 13, 1999,
33 and annually thereafter.

EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill would result in minimal additional costs to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), the Department of Public Works (DPW), and the State Properties Review Board (SPRB), that would be absorbed within existing resources. The bill requires the Commissioner of DAS, the Commissioner of DPW, and the Chairperson of SPRB to study the cost-effectiveness of their programs and submit reports to the Appropriations Committee by January 13, 1999, and annually thereafter.

SB 592

AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENTS OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND PUBLIC WORKS AND THE STATE PROPERTIES REVIEW BOARD

SUMMARY: This bill requires the Commissioner of the

Department of Administrative Services, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Chairperson of the State Properties Review Board to review and evaluate expenditures for their programs and services. They shall submit findings and recommendations to the Appropriations Committee no later than January 13, 1999, and annually thereafter.
